

# To Nail or not to Nail...

**Nail On, Screw On,  
or Glue On?**



Clogging taps have traditionally been nailed onto shoes using shoe tacks. This is still the attachment method of choice for most dancers. Our Nail On design calls for the nails to be inserted on an angle. Properly installed, any nail head that backs out will hit against the outer tap plate and be driven back in while dancing.



Some cloggers like to use a Screw Kit to install their taps themselves.
